Year 3 and Year 4 pupils had an interesting lesson from The Animal Man on Thursday, 18th March 2021 learning all about animals, bones and their skeleton. Lots of interesting questions were asked and answered, currently linked to their science topic.

School News

<u>Year 3</u>

Science – Animals, bones and their skeletons.

There current class book read is George's Marvelous Medicine by Roald Dahl and they are enjoying comprehensions and also re telling the story.

Music is being composed on our new Glockenspiels in the classroom and learning about fractions in maths.

Ancient Egyptians is the history topic, where they are learning new facts on Egyptian artefacts and how they are used in everyday life.

The year group are busily preparing recording an Easter video for parents/carers and the rest of the school.

<u>Year 4</u>

Science – Animals, bones and their skeletons.

Electricity is their current science topic and they are understanding how electricity is created and how appliances are powered by electricity.

Treasure Island by Louis Stevenson is the class read where the children are understanding the text and re telling the story with fractions in maths.

Roman Britain and typical roman Life is being discussed as part of their current History topic.

<u>Year 5</u>

Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens is being read as their English text and applying their comprehension skills. The story is captivating the class and they look forward to each instalment with excitement and re telling it.

The pupils are learning about the six towns and their physical features of Stoke on Trent in geography and learning to read OS maps.

There current science topic in science is changing materials with chemical reactions, melting and re heating.

All year groups are practising their athletic skills in PE in preparation for a possible Summer Sports Day Event.

<u>Year 6</u>

Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone is their current class read.

The children are participating in very lively Rainforest debates on the topic of deforestation and should it or not happen and on its effects on our planet. There are lively debates on both sides of the argument.

Fractions are being taught in maths and their science topic is also animals and humans.
